SATISFACTORY

I found High School Musical the movie to be <u>unfamiliar</u> because the actors are part of singing groups. I was never part of a singing group, so I am unfamiliar with this.

BETTER

I found High School Musical the movie to be <u>unfamiliar</u> because the actors are part of singing groups.
