Journalism Principles and Practices CRN 30591

Date: May 27 to June 13 (First session)

Time: MTWR 9:00–12:00

This course introduces students to the world of journalism: the culture, commerce, ethics, history, working conditions, rights, responsibilities, standard practices, and effects of evolving technology. Students learn about the nature of a journalism career and gather information that will serve as a foundation for their future journalism skills as well as for their lecture and seminar courses. Online Journalism I CRN 30590

This course examines what makes online journalism unique. Students gain this knowledge through a series of reporting, writing and multimedia production assignments. They also build their own online news publication. The course fulfills a requirement for Journalism majors and minors and for students in the New Media Concentration. Also a great elective for students studying Public Relations, Radio/Television/Film, or Writing Arts.

Media Ethics – ONLINE COURSE CRN 30498

Date: June 3 to July 28 *Online*

Media Ethics examines decision-making in media professions. The course examines the moral aspects of media conduct, and helps the student develop a more complete understanding of not only the historical background of ethics, but how the interplay of politics, science, economics, law, philosophy, and other disciplines have influenced the way we view right and wrong. The course also strengthens analytical skills as they relate to ethical decisions, cultivating a perception of how media professionals come to a decision and the many factors that influence that decision.
